- 21 BURRY PORT & GWENDRAETH VALLEY RAILWAY 3rd class single from Trimsaran Rd to Burry Port (dated 1/8/1921) in VGC apart from (Bm). (1)



- 22 METROPOLITAN RAILWAY issued mostly 3rd class singles to destinations on railways foreign to the Met comprising Aldgate (Met) to Bethnal

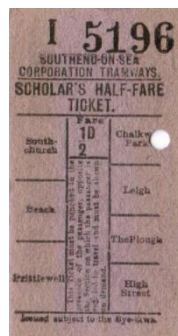

- 24 SER (10) AND SOUTH EASTERN & CHATHAM RAILWAY (100) (untitled) selection of mixed **LUGGAGE LABELS** offering a good variety of destinations. Mainly good/VGC with vibrant colours. Some of the more unusual types featured, plus some miscellaneous land routing labels. All different. (124)



- 25 NORTH SUNDERLAND RAILWAY mostly issued whole all from Seahouses comprising 1st (u) and 3rd singles, 1st whole return (u), Dog single, Bicycle single. Mostly good/VGC. (5)



- 26 A COLLECTION of 15 punch type **TRAM TICKETS** from SOUTHDOWN-ON-SEA CORPORATION TRAMWAYS, all in "fareboard" (named stage) format; the earliest of these is a Whiting printed issue from the Leigh-on-Sea Section, which dates from the early 1900s. 35 GREAT EASTERN RAILWAY issued whole all from St Pancras comprising 3rd return to Godmanchester (0000) (dated 24/11/1900), 3rd return to St Ives (dated 16/4/1908) (both very neatly rejoined) and early print 3rd single to Wretham (dated 30/7/1877) (✓). All have a little (Bm) good/VGC mostly. (3)



36 SCHULL & SKIBBEREEN TRAMWAY undated Edmondson card 3rd class single from Schull to Ballydehob in VGC. The service was replaced by buses in January 1947. (1)



37 BR(W/M) WEST MIDLANDS AREA all issued mostly transitional whole from Coalport LM, Daimler Halt, Dunchurch, Hampton Loade, Lawley Bank, Northwood Halt, Oakengates LM, Oakengates West, Rugby (Midland), Wolverhampton (1979 issue). (10)

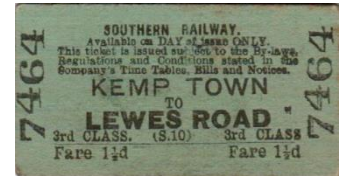

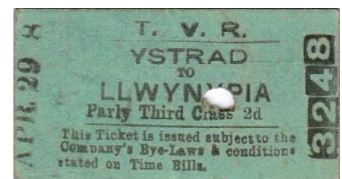


42 SOUTHERN RAILWAY 3rd class single from Kemp Town to Lewes Road (dated 20/8/1926) in good condition with light foxing and slight (Bm). Both stations closed on 2/1/1933. (1)

49 EAST SUFFOLK RAILWAY/GER (untitled) return half of a 1st class return from Framlingham to Parham, (dated July 1868). The railway was opened by the ESR in June 1859, but taken over by the GER in August 1862; the ticket may date from the ESR period, but is perhaps more likely to have been produced by the GER. VGC. (1hf)



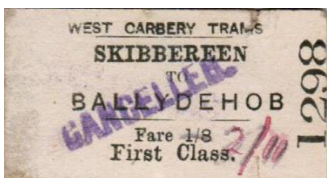
50 NORTH LONDON RAILWAY early untitled 2nd class Single from Bow to Victoria Park, issued April 1867. A little (Bm), VGC otherwise. (1)



51 MID-SUFFOLK LIGHT RAILWAY issued blank 3rd class Privilege Ticket single from Laxfield made out to Stradbroke @ (dated 27/2/1921). (Bm) otherwise VGC. (1)

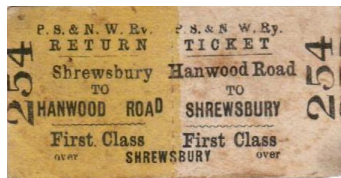


52 AXHOLME JOINT RAILWAY issued 3rd class single from Crowle to Wakefield (Kirkgate) (dated 26/6/1925). Slightly scruffy due to notes in green ink made by the auditor on the face, good otherwise except for (Bm). (1)



53 WEST CARBERY TRAMS 1st class Edmondson card **TRAM TICKET** single from Skibbreen to Ballydehob (overstamped "Cancelled") and fare adjusted in crayon. Good condition except for (Bm). A 3' gauge steam tramway, West Carbery Trams was the original name given to the Schull & Skibbreen Tramway. The line closed in January 1947. (1)

54 BR. Approx 350-400 mainly transitional style **LUGGAGE LABELS** most of which are from the Southern Region. Many have continued the pre-Nat stock numbers, but later BR references noted also. Minor duplication possible. (Qty)



55 POTTERIES SHREWSBURY & NORTH WALES RAILWAY 1st class Return from Hanwood Road to Shrewsbury, unused, some foxing, plus an unused paper ticket for "Soldiers, Policemen on Duty and Shipwrecked Mariners" with 1860s pre-printed date. (2)



56 KIDDERMINSTER AND STOURPORT ELECTRIC TRAMWAY COMPANY 2d red/white **TRAM TICKETS** for the Prospect Road Stourport – North Avenue Kidderminster line. Closed on 2/4/1929. Slight (Bd) good otherwise. (1)
