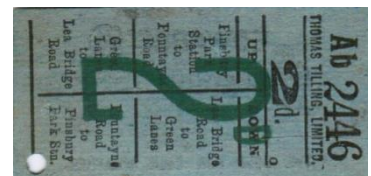

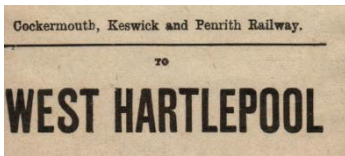
- 2 BAKER STREET & WATERLOO RAILWAY issued singles from Embankment (Charing Cross), Oxford Circus, Piccadilly Circus, Piccadilly Circus No 1 (to Westminster Bridge Road for Waterloo), Trafalgar Square (2 different), Waterloo (2 different), plus a thin card 2d ticket for a Single Journey to or from Any Station. All in good/VGC but mostly

pasted to card. (9)



- 3 THOMAS TILLING Ltd all different geographical punch type **BUS TICKETS** mostly from South London routes at fares between 1/2d and 5d, but also included is a 2d blue form North London route Finsbury Park Station – Lea Bridge Road. All have either green or red fare overprints. Mostly good/VGC. (9)

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- 4 COCKERMOUTH KESWICK AND PENRITH RAILWAY type C51 **LUGGAGE LABELS** including to Barnard Castle, Beattock, Darlington Bank Top NE, Hexham, Morecambe, Nuneaton, Redcar, Rugby, Stockport, Stranraer, Tynemouth, West Hartlepool, Willesden, etc. One or two have slight faults, good/VGC otherwise. 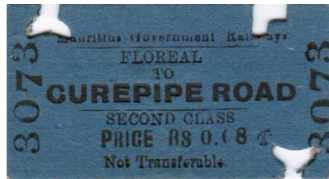

- 7 BR(W/S) all issued mostly 2nd and 3rd class whole from WEST COUNTRY STATIONS including Barnstaple Junc, Braunton, Brentor, Bridport, Broadstone, Budleigh Salterton, Melford, Chard Junction, Egloskerry (Accompanied Article), Gunnislake, Halwill, Launceston, Maiden Newton, Port Isaac Road, St Ives, Salisbury, Saltash, Sturminster Newton, Templecombe, etc. All different. (30)



- 8 THOMAS TILLING all different 1916-1923 pattern fareboard geographical punch type motor **BUS TICKETS**

from services 75 and 75X. All have the anonymous "Omnibus Ticket" title. Mostly good/VGC. (16)
